SMALL STUDY GRANTS FOR SCHOOLS IN BHUTAN

The Royal Society for Protection of Nature (RSPN), in partnership with the Bhutan National Commission for UNESCO (Bhutan NatCom) under the Ministry of Education and Skills Development (MoESD), is pleased to invite applications for the 2025 Small Study Grants Program.

Objective of the Study Grant

This grant supports schools with **UNESCO Clubs, ASPnet Schools, or Nature Clubs** in developing **innovative solutions** to address local environmental challenges. The program encourages students to:

- Identify **pressing environmental issues** in their communities.
- Document the impacts on **local biodiversity and climate**.
- Conduct **biodiversity surveys** with student and stakeholder participation.
- Propose **nature-positive solutions** using **STEM-based approaches**.

ASPnet Club

The UNESCO Associated Schools Network (ASPnet) is a global network of millions of students, teachers, principals and wider school communities, who are committed to promoting and transmitting UNESCO's values through education. The Network operates at international and national levels with three clear priorities: education for sustainable development, global citizenship education and inter-cultural and heritage learning.

Nature Club

A Nature Club is a school-based initiative established in the 1990s by RSPN in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Skills Development to promote environmental education and awareness among students and surrounding communities. To support the program, RSPN developed activity manuals, management guides, and trained over 1,000 teachers. In partnership with the





erstwhile Royal Education Council, RSPN also introduced the Environmental Science curriculum for grade IX and X and extended the program to monastic schools.

The Royal Society for Protection Nature (RSPN) is the country's oldest Environmental NGO. Established in 1987 under the Royal Command of His Majesty Fourth King, the organization is dedicated to the conservation of the environment through innovative solutions.
